

RosettaNet and GS1 India Collaborate To Conduct Training in Bangalore

RosettaNet and GS1 India conducted a [two-day training course](#) in Bangalore on 26-27 September 2007. Thirty-seven people from multi-national and multi-local firms attended the training. The course provides a comprehensive overview of the RosettaNet community, the RosettaNet standards, and implementation case studies / business outcomes. Resources with a business and technical orientation find value in the program when they are beginning an implementation initiative and need to gain a lot of knowledge in a short amount of time.

RosettaNet and Nanyang Polytechnic of Singapore co-develop the training and offer certificates upon completion.

Ravi Mathur, CEO of GS1 India stated, "There is a unique opportunity in India for RosettaNet due to the low penetration of B2B solutions for multi-national and national companies."
